ACCESS

The property is located northeast of Beardmore. Travel east from Beardmore on Highway #11 for 15 miles then north on secondary Highway #801 for 8 miles, then northeast on a lumber road for about 5 miles. This road runs through the northeast corner of the claim.

A new logging road intersects the main road at this corner and progresses SW through the claim group.

PROSPECTING TARGETS

Commodity: Main Au: Secondary: Cu, Pb, Zn

DEPOSIT TYPE & GEOLOGY

The project area is completely within the Coyle Lake Stock, granite granodiorite. The contact with the intermediate to felsic metavolcanics to the north are just south of the Sturgeon river and are within the north-east corner of the claim group. The wide gold bearing quartz vein east of East Coyle Lake is on a north-east trending break possibly coming up from the main regional Paint Lake fault. This vein is hosted by a medium to coarse grained quartz diorite or granodiorite. An intensely sheared intermediate volcanic lies along the north contact of the vein. The quartz vein is well fractured with considerable malachite staining throughout. Fine disseminated chalcopyrite is found periodically throughout the vein and in some places the chalcopyrite occurs in massive blebs and seams. Some coarse patches of pyrite are found but mostly the pyrite occurs as finely disseminated throughout.

Floats found in the drift, down ice of a series of north-east trending conductors in the central and eastern portion of TB1209268, were of a very hard, brittle silicious nature almost like a rhyolite with very fine disseminated pyrite throughout. The fine pyrite is heavily concentrated in places and would be considered semi-massive to massive in some cases, undoubtedly the cause of this series of NE trending VLF signatures.

GEOLOGY

My 1996 OPAP prospecting has not added to the geology of the property. Granite-Granodiorite blanket the entire claim group, except for the area hosting the discovery vein. This is a 16ft wide gold bearing quartz vein and is on a north-east trending break. The vein is hosted by a medium to coarse grained quartz diorite or granodiorite. An intensely sheared intermediate volcanic lies along the north contact of the vein. The quartz vein is well fractured with disseminated pyrite and calcopyrite. The calcopyrite is sometimes found in massive blebs and seams.

Heavily mineralized felsic floats are scattered throughout the entire claim group. This would indicate a very wide band of volcanics trending north east and in the conductive areas on the east side of the claim group; however, these targets could not be reached because of heavy overburden. The floats were assayed for gold and returned nil results.

REPORT on 1996 DPAP Exploration Program
O.P.A.P. # OP96-027 Dave Kindla - Elmhirst T.W.P.

My program began in late June. Extensive traversing was done in the new cut over areas and along the new road right of ways. The equipment used in the logging operation revealed many outcrops in the central and south western part of TB-1209268; however, the majority of outcrops observed were all granite.

Prospecting and traverses across the formation were also done in the cut over areas and new road ways on TB -1209269 and TB-1204933.

With the exception of numerous well mineralized floats that are scattered all over the claim group, all of the outcrops exposed are granite.

Many days were spent trying to gain access to the discovery vein from the east, however this is very rough mountainous country, and access for the backhoe would be too time consuming, dangerous, and costly.

A new road was put in and logging operations started in the south west part of TB-1209268. This made it possible to gain access to the west end of the vein.

Backhoe trenches were put down in the approximate location of Airborne conductors, most targets could not be reached because of water or heavy overburden.

The discovery vein was stripped off for approximately 400 feet before pinching out. The trench was continued for another 300 feet following a narrow shear zone, the main vein did not reappear.

The main vein was cross trenched and washed for almost its full length and also sampled.

Values seem to be confined to the shaft area. Samples taken away from the shaft did not assay.

On October 23 the resident geologist, John Mason was taken on a property visit. The samples taken on his visit were sent for assay to MNDM but the results were not back in time for this report.

A junior company is interested in optioning the property; however, nothing was signed at the time of this report.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The only area that was not thoroughly investigated is claim TB1204930

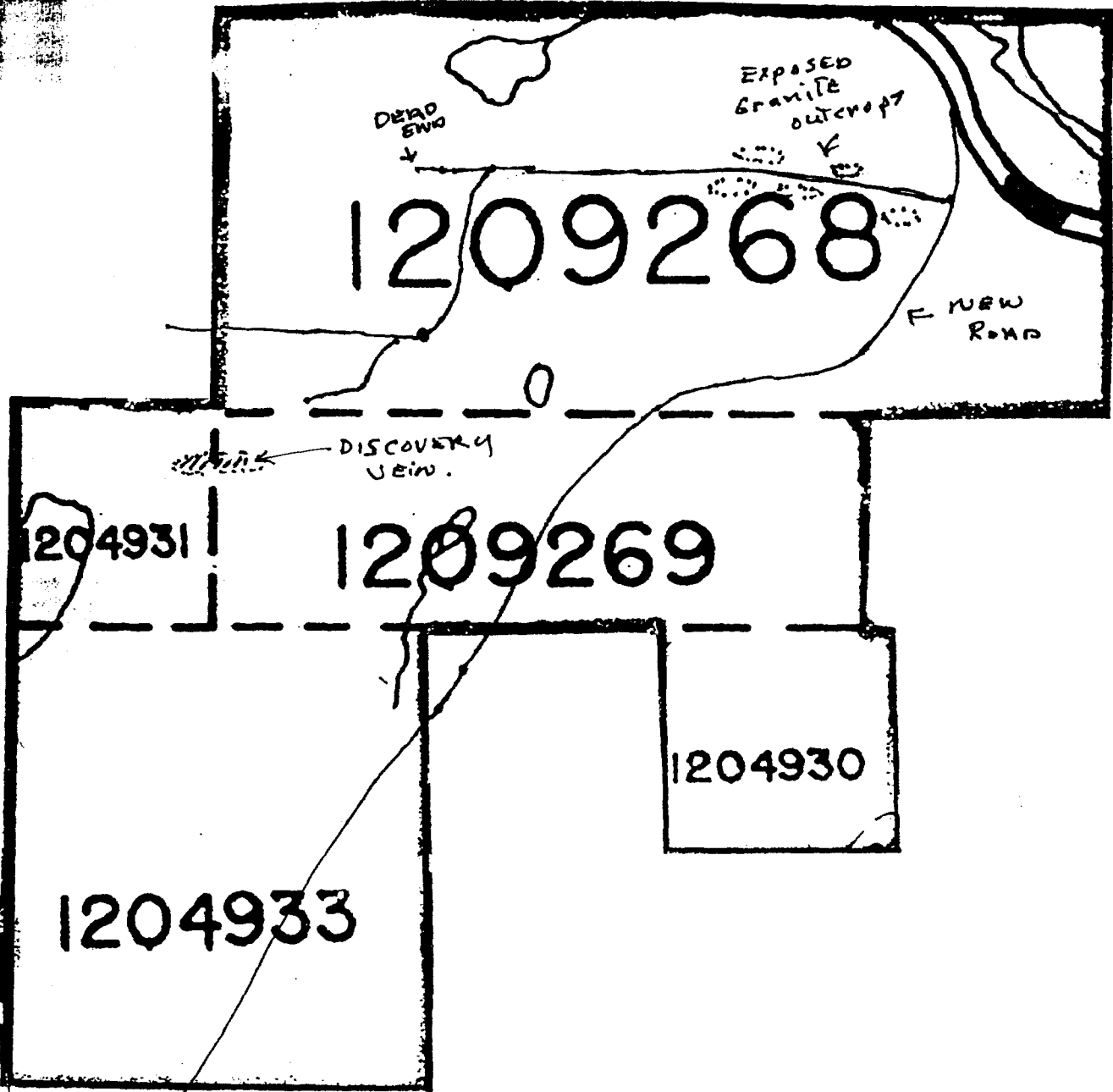
The logging operation was moving into that area when I finished my program.

The property is now ready for a drill program to investigate the discovery vein at depth. A Junior company has visited the property and I am waiting for a letter of intent.

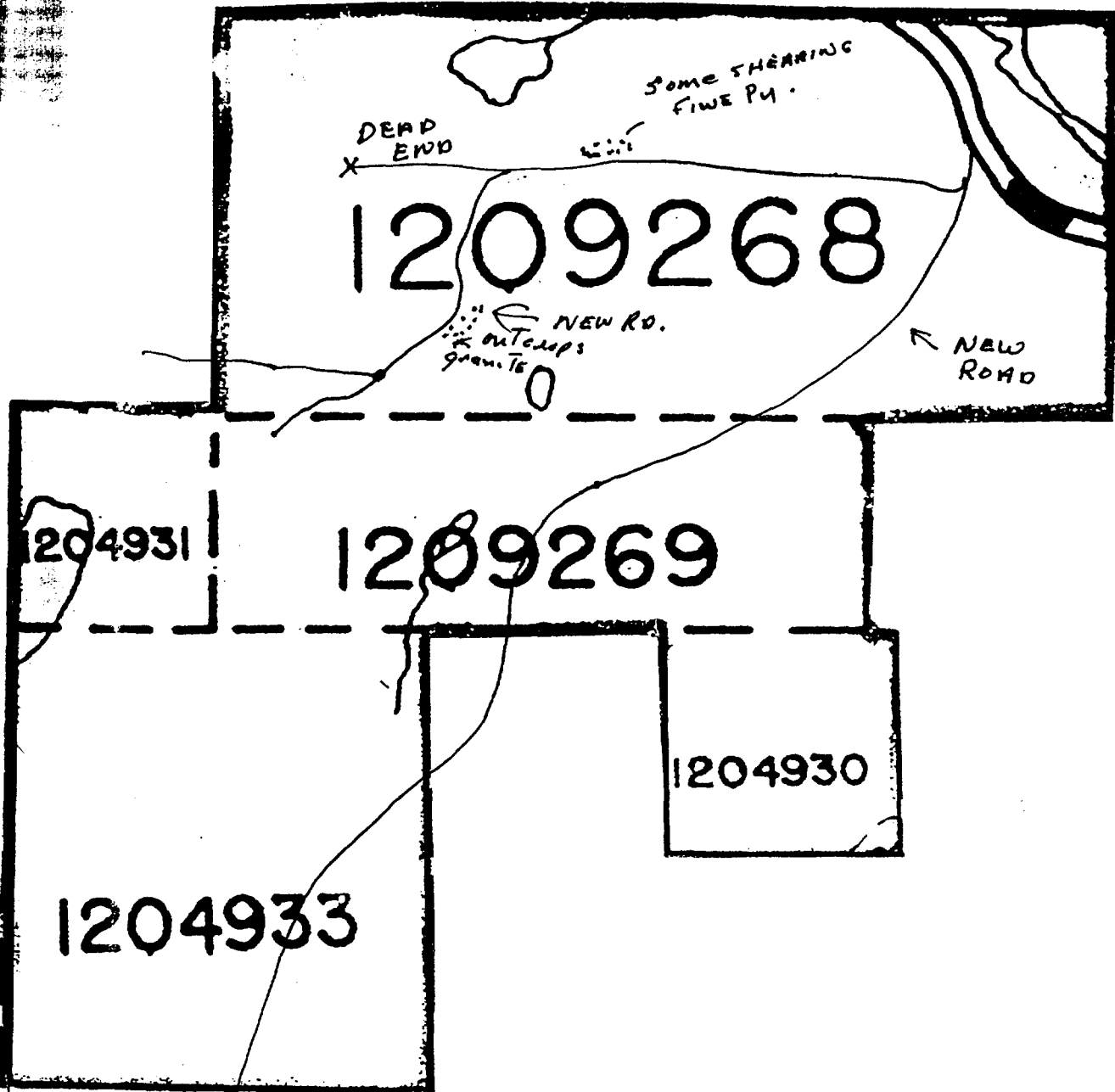

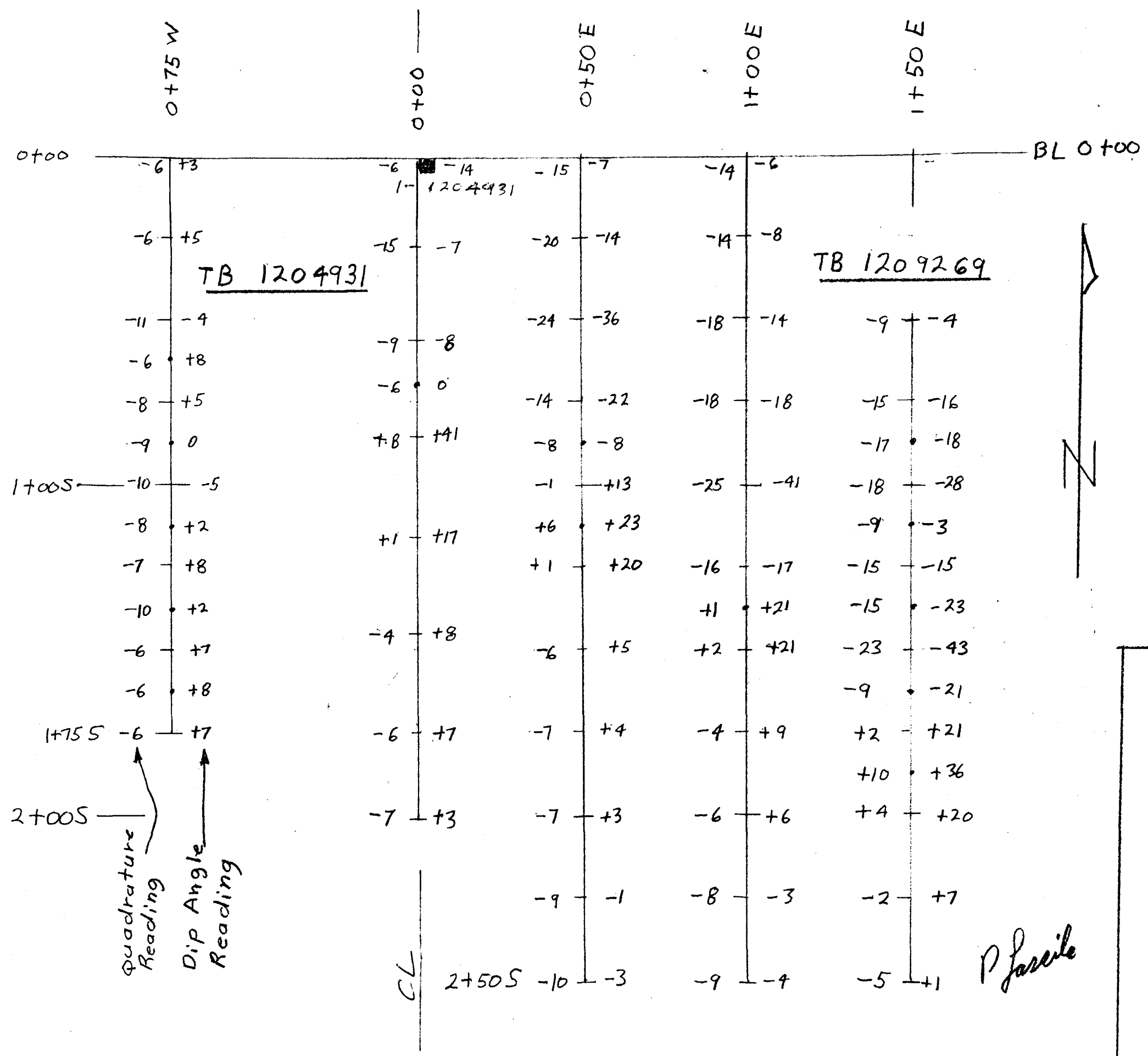


VLF SURVEY MAP

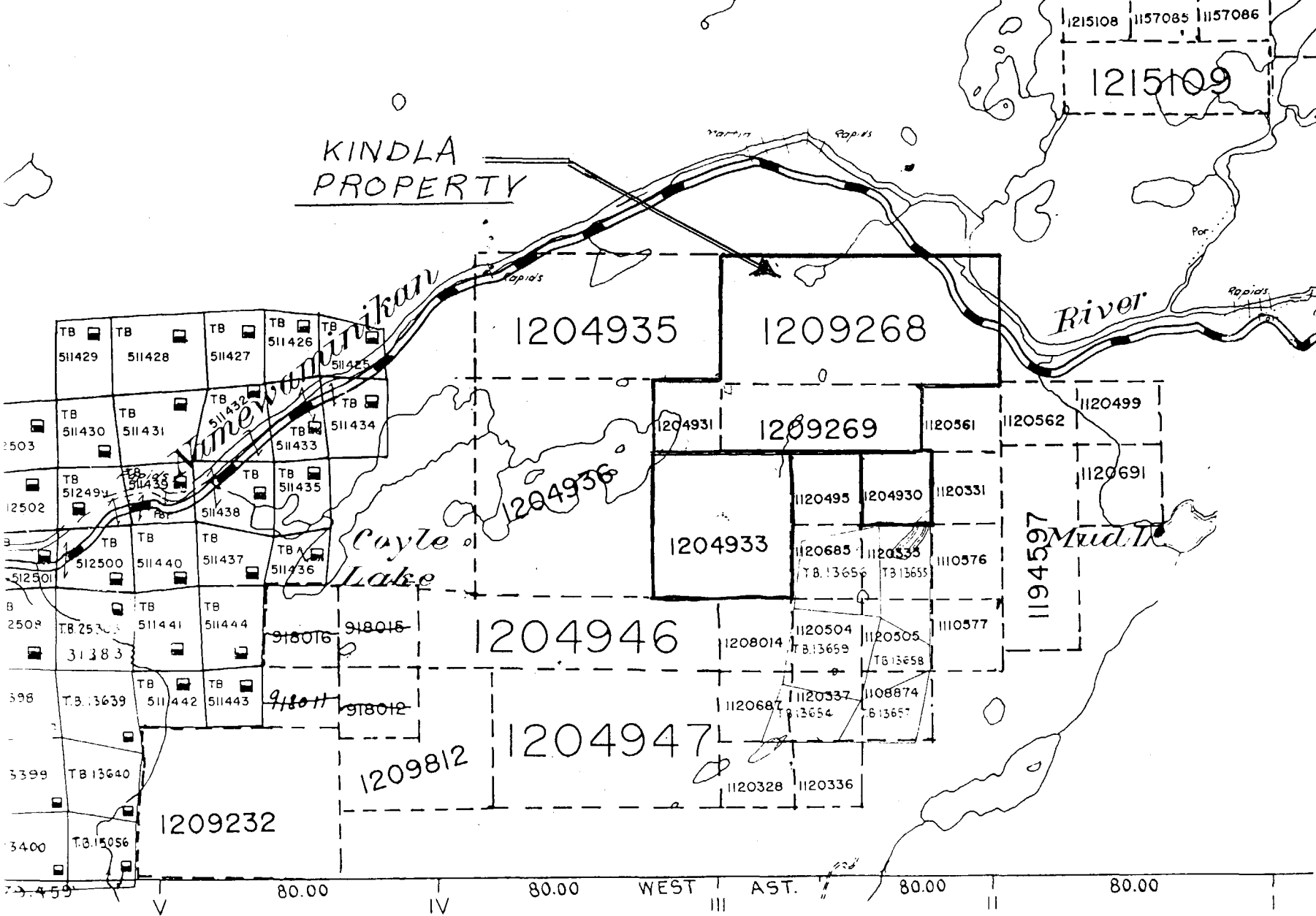

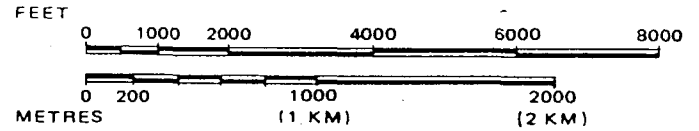
VLF READINGS MAP
